

Easy Neck Warmer/headband

The perfect Christmas or birthday gift! It's quick, easy and only takes 100yards of worsted yarn. Whether your neck is cold in the office or you are heading up to the mountains, you'll want to take a couple along in a few different colors! Don't stick with just the basic pattern, add pins, buttons, patches, embroidery or crocheted flowers to really make it your own and show off your sense of style.

Finished size:

Width: stretched: 23, unstretched: 14 ½"

Length: 5 ¼"

Materials:

Yarn: 100 yards of worsted weight yarn such as; Cascade 220, Noro Kureyon, Wool-ease.

Needle:

size 8 16" circular for the In-the-round version,
size 8 straights for the Flat-seamed version.

Gauge: unstretched: 26sts. Per 4ins. In 2x2 rib,
stretched: 18sts. Per 4in. in 2x2 rib

Directions for In-the-round:

Loosely cast on 104sts.

Work all rows: "k2, p2" until work measures 5ins.

Bind off in pattern.

Weave in ends.

Directions for Flat-seamed-version:

Loosely cast on 106sts.

Work in Row 1: "k2,p2" to last 2sts. K2

Row 2: "p2, k2" to last 2sts. P2

Repeat 1&2 until work measures 5ins.

Bind off in pattern.

Seam (sew) side together.

Weave in ends.
